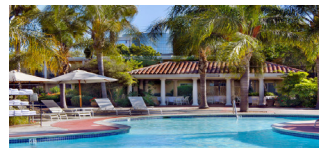

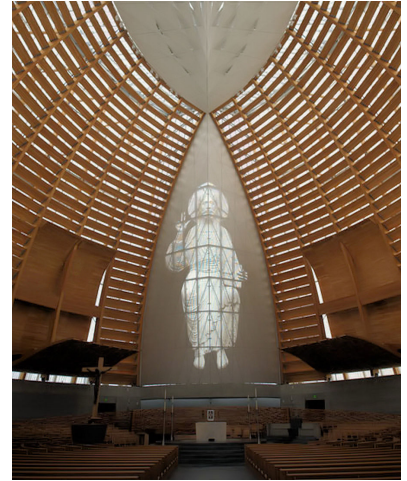


# TOUR B
